CYCLE 1	Changing market and technology conditions	Capacity of supervisors to respond and to help others respond	Propose a project to design, develop, and deliver training to build adaptive capacity
CYCLE 2	Project constraints about schedules, budget, expectations of management and supervisors	Pragmatism; union relationships; diverse interest and experience with change; age; education	Design training program to build knowledge and skills for adaptive capacity
CYCLE 3	Learners not engaging with each other or leader	Desire for relevance, clarity, practicality, credit for what they know	Adjust design to create conditions that are more safe and learner-driven
CYCLE 4	Curiosity and eagerness to apply	Practice in class inspires desire to practice in real world	Establish opportunities for peer feedback and response following training
